- Combat Management Systems: Lockheed Martin Canada – Aegis with CMS 330

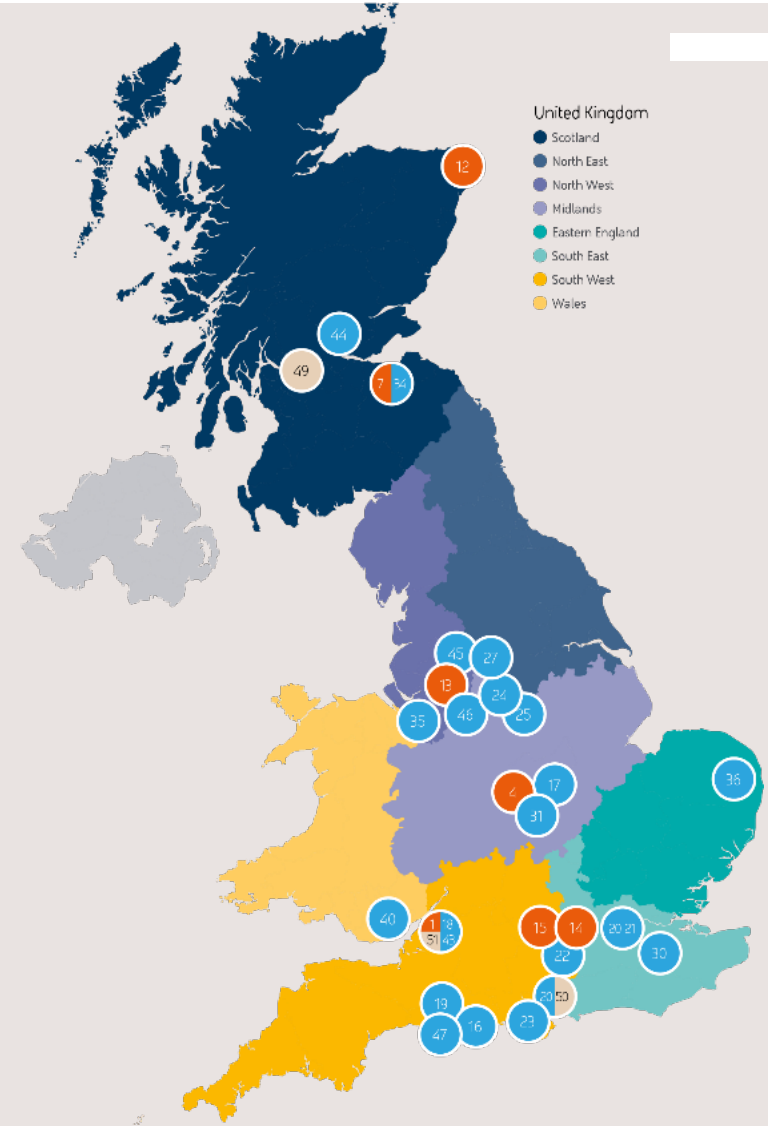

The Canadian Surface Combatant programme

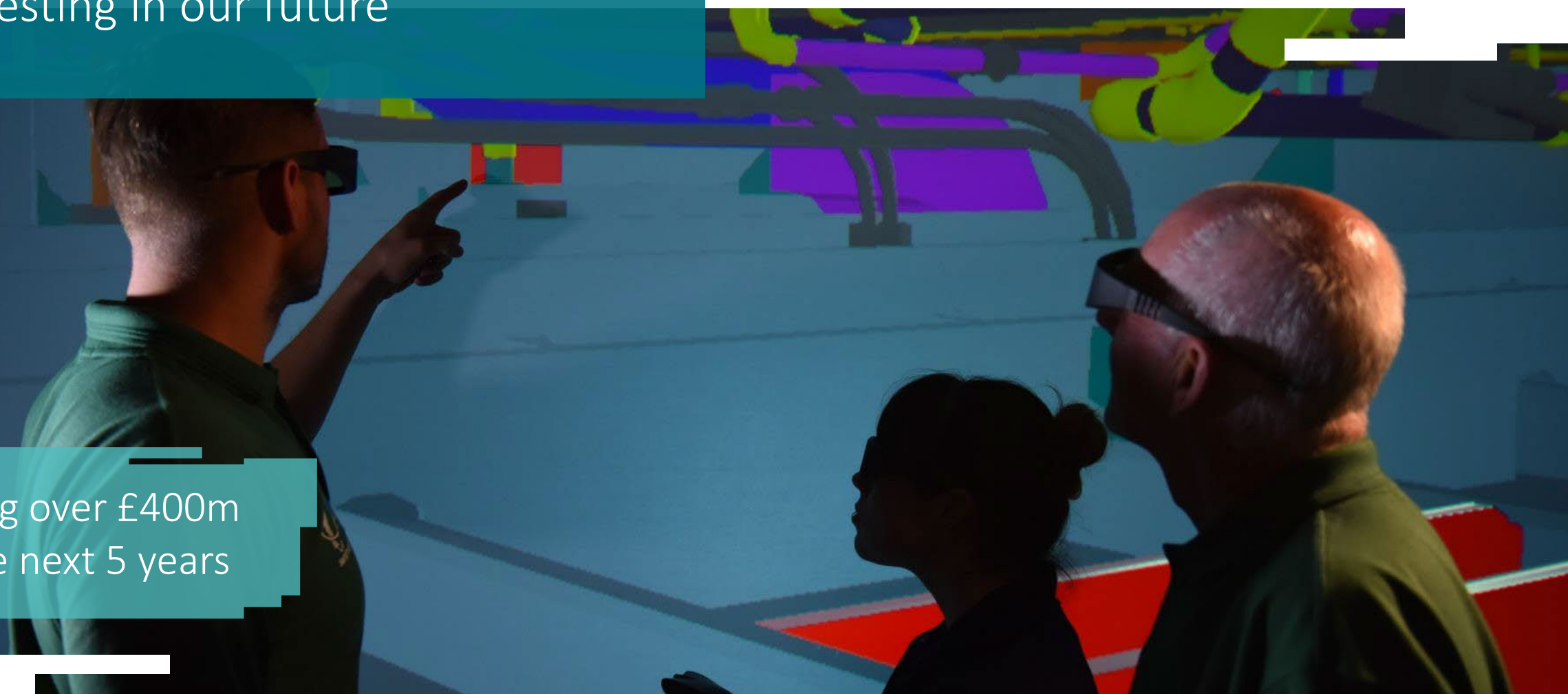
- Class of 15 ships

Value of GCS export to UK economy £6Bn



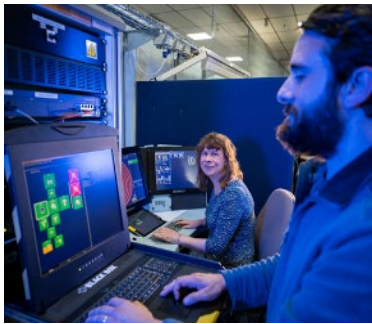

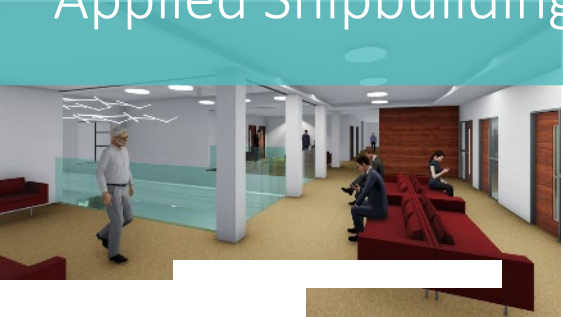

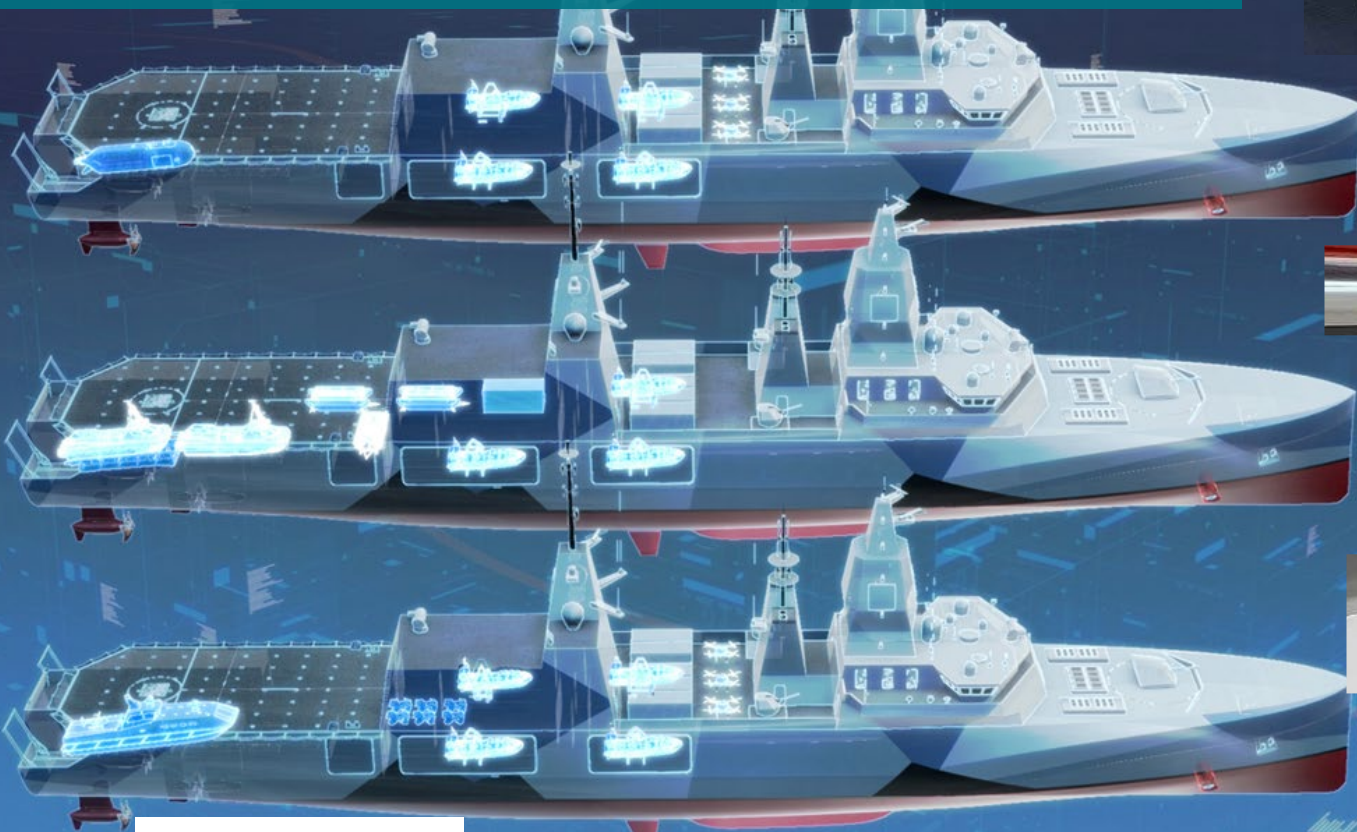
